<i>Summery red blend of Pinot, Syrah &amp; Meunier. Vibrant fruits, herbs &amp; spice with a brisk acidity and a general prettiness.</i>			12/58

<i>Plums, sour cherries, smokey chocolate</i>			10/48
<b>Castelli The Sum Shiraz</b>	2016	Great Southern
